The past five EMPTISTORY Women International Fire Conference had rooted on exploratory, information and education in positioning of women and Kingdom stewardship to the tenets of sustainable ministry on the import of Acts 9:15 “But the Lord said to him, “Go, for he is a chosen vessel of Mine to bear My name before Gentiles, kings, and the children of Israel”. Secondly, to transform from bitter to better, we need to “put off the old man” to embrace our spiritual foundation rooted on Christ Jesus and the importance of building faithfully with presence of God into our ministry.

Thirdly, to transform from bitter to better we need to put on the “new man” to reflect on the teaching of our Lord Jesus Christ and affirm the need for positive attitude in advancing from bitter to better through realities of humanity.

Fourth, to transform from bitter to better we need to “renew the mind” to integrate spiritual accelerator to bring the rudiments of prayer models, EMPTISTORY, Multicultural sensitivity and interspiritual collaboration.

The 6th EMPTISTORY Women International Fire conference will work from transforming us from bitter to better through:

- Fostering supportive community for sharing experiences and encouragement.
